Wal-Roc USBC Open Championship Tournament Rules

- 1. All bowlers must be current members of USBC. The tournament is certified by the United State Bowling Congress and is handicapped and will be based on a scratch figure of 225 at 90% for any event. No deductions for averages over 225. For bowlers not sanctioned through Wal-Roc USBC there will be a \$15.00 participation fee.
- 2. Entrants will use their highest USBC sanctioned league average of 21 games or more from the previous season. If an entrant has no previous winter season average, the highest current average in one league as of January 15 of this year shall be used. If an entrant has no previous winter season average or current league average, the highest summer league average for at least 21 games as of the end of the previous summer league shall be used.

If none of the above apply, an entrant without a 21 game average as of January 15 shall be permitted to bowl in the tournament using his/her HIGHEST current average of at least 9 games as of January 15 whether bowled as a regular member or as a substitute. ALL other entrants must bowl scratch of 225.

Each entrant is responsible for his/her average being submitted correctly. In the event averages are reported incorrectly, the bowler can be disqualified. USBC Rule 319a, 2 does apply. (If a bowlers' average is more than 15 pins over the last season, he/she does have to use the new average). Rules 319d (reporting of prior tournament prize winnings shall not apply).

- 3. Members may participate in all of the events with the exception of all events as often as they would like as long as they change 2 members for the team event and one member for the doubles event, singles can be bowled as many times as doubles. Make up teams are permitted. When a bowler competes more than once, his/her first appearance in team, doubles and single events shall count toward his/her all-events, which is the total of team, doubles & singles. All events must be paid for before the first ball is thrown in the tournament.
- 4. Substitutes will be permitted when replacement is necessary. The tournament manager should be notified of a substitution at least ½ hour before scheduled bowling time, IF POSSIBLE. In case of emergency after a game has started, a substitute, if one is available, shall be permitted to bowl in the team and doubles event only. The combine scores will count in either of these events. If no substitute is available, only the actual score of the frames bowled shall be used. If bowler leaves in between games, the average of the games bowled for that event will be used. A BOWLER ARRIVING LATE WILL RECEIVE 0 FOR THE FRAMES MISSED.
- 5. When ties for other than first place occur, the prize money will be combined and divided equally among the tied position winner. In case of tie for first place, a roll-off shall be held within 10 days. Date and time of such a roll-off shall be set by the tournament manager. The expenses for bowling will be paid for by the association.
- 6. Prizes will be paid on handicap scores with at least one prize for every four entries based on the number of entries. Cash will be awarded for handicap winner. One in every seven participants will be paid out in All-Events. Prize money paid into each event shall be returned 100% to the winners in that event.
- 7. A squad sponsor (individual) of five teams or more in the same envelope will receive a free entry which includes team event, doubles event and singles event. All events and scratch events are not included.
- 8. The Board of Directors of the Wal-Roc USBC shall act on all protests and decide any questions not covered by these tournament rules.
